Buxus, Roses and Ornamentals	Blight and dieback, phytophthora and pythium root rots	6ml per litre of water. Spray every 30 days during growing season (Sept - March). Ensure complete foliar coverage to point of run off.
Roses	Downy mildew	6ml per litre of water. Spray at signs of disease every 30 days during spring (Sept - Nov).
Buxus, Roses, other Ornamentals	Transplant Stress	Gently soak the soil around the roots with 6ml per litre of water then plant. Recommended to combine with Grosafe BioPower Seaweed and Organic Root-Gro for increased benefit during transplant.

PRECAUTIONS: Do not apply this product on crops that will be consumed as food by humans or animals. Do not mix with copper or spraying oil.
