Premium quality biodegradable wetting and spreading agent for use with insecticides, fungicides and herbicides.

ACTIVE INGREDIENT: Contains 1000 g/litre alkoxylated alcohols

PERSONAL PROTECTION: When mixing or loading wear overalls, impervious gloves and eye/ face protection. Do not breathe fumes/mist/vapours/spray. Wash hands and exposed skin thoroughly before rest or meal breaks, and after work.

ENVIRONMENT: Toxic to aquatic life.; Harmful to terrestrial vertebrates. Avoid release to the environment, and contamination of any water supply with product or empty container.

STORAGE: Store in original container tightly closed and in a locked, dry, cool, well ventilated area, away from foodstuffs. When stored appropriately this product should show no significant degradation for 2 years from the date of manufacture. Contact the distributor for further information about the use of this product if it is older than this.

SPILLS AND DISPOSAL: When dealing with spills wear personal protective clothing and equipment as described in the PERSONAL PROTECTION section. Contain and absorb with suitable inert absorbent material and store in properly labelled, sealed drums for safe disposal. If spray mixture is spilled absorb and collect in drums as above. Deal with all spillages immediately. If contamination of drains, streams, watercourses, etc. is unavoidable, warn the local water authority.

PRODUCT DISPOSAL: If possible dispose of by using according to the label, or in accordance with the local regulations.

CONTAINER DISPOSAL: Triple rinse container and dispose of via recycling scheme. Otherwise bury in a suitable land fill.

GENERAL INFORMATION:

Optispread® 1000 is a premium quality, biodegradable, non-ionic surfactant for agricultural and horticultural sprays. It contains 100% w/v active ingredients suitable for use with most fungicides, insecticides and herbicides.

Optispread® 1000 reduces the surface tension of spray droplets causing them to spread and adhere to the target in a continuous film. This assists penetration and uptake of the spray on to waxy or hairy plant surfaces, fungus lesions and insects.

Herbicide Sprays: Optispread® 1000 can be added to many herbicide sprays to increase their efficiency. Use only where directed on individual labels, as use with selective herbicides outside label directions may reduce crop selectivity.

For foliar active herbicides, spray to the point where leaves and stem are just wet. Spraying beyond this point will cause run-off and loss of spray chemicals. When spraying hard to wet waxy or hairy leafed plants, increasing the rates of Optispread® 1000 can increase activity. When treating dense, tall vegetation with foliar herbicides it is important to thoroughly wet all leaves and stems for efficient herbicide performance.

Mixing: Optispread® 1000 mixes easily with water and should be added directly to the spray tank after the addition of other components. Optispread® 1000 can be used with acid and alkaline sprays.

Optispread® 1000 should not be used with products where the label prohibits the use of surfactants, or where the formulations has sufficient wetter.
