| Tanker/Vehicle Accident | Switch off engine and electrical equipment. Keep people away, warn other traffic. Check for spills, leaks. Dial 111 |
| Spill or Leak | Sweep up spilled product, collect and place in sealable container for disposal. Seek advice from the local authority regarding disposal. |
| Fire | Dial 111. Wear full personal protective equipment including with self-contained breathing apparatus (SCBA). Use water spray, alcohol resistant foam, dry powder or carbon dioxide. Contain to prevent runoff into drains, sewers, waterways. |
