EMERGENCY PROCEDURES

IF THIS HAPPENS	DO THIS
Tanker/Vehicle Accident	Switch off engine and electrical equipment. Keep people away, warn other traffic. Check for spills, leaks. Dial 111
Spill or Leak	Wear overalls, chemical resistant gloves, boots and safety goggles. Prevent further leakage. Absorb spillage with lime or clay, collect and place in sealable container for disposal. Wash down affected area with water plus detergent. Absorb and collect washings. Seek advice from the local authority regarding disposal.
Fire	Dial 111. Product may give off harmful fumes. Wear full protective clothing and breathing apparatus. Use extinguisher suitable for surrounding environment and materials. Cool steel drums with water to prevent explosion by thermal expansion. Consider evacuation of the immediate area.

FIRST AID

If On Skin	Immediately remove contaminated clothing and wash affected areas thoroughly with soap and water. Seek medical advice.
If Inhaled	Remove from exposure. If not breathing give artificial respiration (mouth to nose). Allow patient to assume the most comfortable position and keep warm. Seek medical advice.
