Spill or Leak	(Wear full protective clothing including self-contained breathing apparatus. Prevent further leakage. Collect spilled material and place in sealable container for disposal. Wash down affected area with water plus detergent. Absorb and collect washings. Seek advice from the local authority regarding disposal.									
Fire			Dial 111 for Fire Service. Wear full protective clothing and breathing apparatus. During fire toxic fumes/gases may be released. Use fine water spray to extinguish fire. Consider evacuation of the immediate area.
